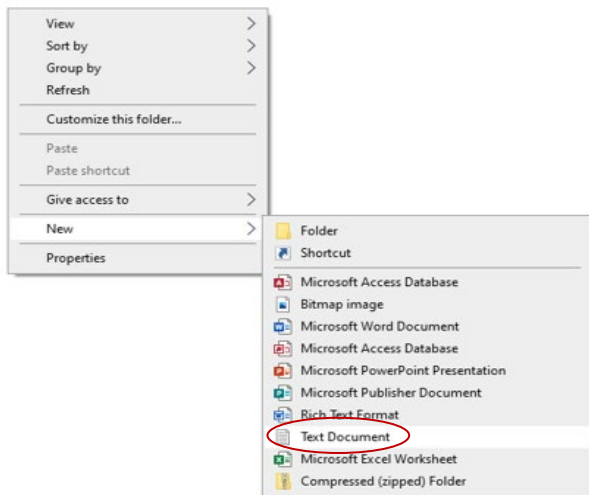


Adding GNSS Subscription/Activation Via USB

To enter a GNSS code into the MaveriX via USB, you will, first, need to purchase a subscription or activation from your Outback Guidance dealer. It will then be shipped to you in two forms. One will be a .gnsslicense file with the code already in the file and the second would be the code in long form for manual entry. If you do not have the .gnsslicense file, follow the directions below to create one. Then follow the later instructions on how to install the subscription or activation via USB.

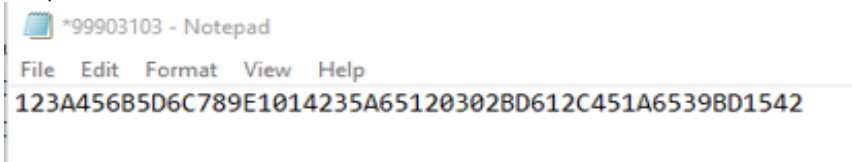
1. Get a code from Outback Guidance (Pandora when it is launched)
2. Make a .txt file



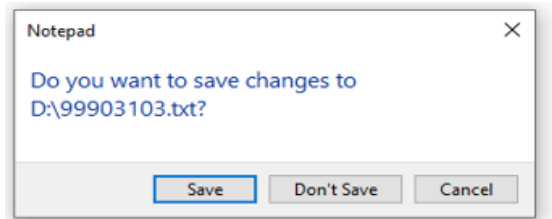
3. Rename .txt file to ESN of antenna

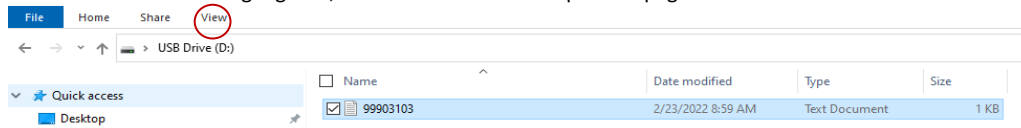
4. Open file and then enter code



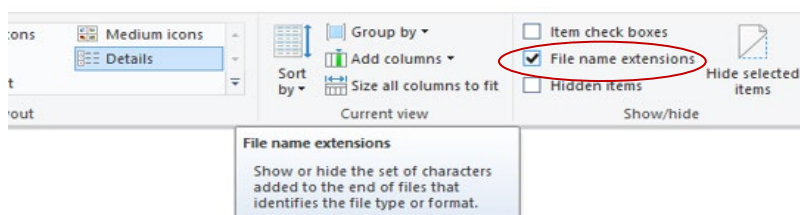
5. Click "Save"



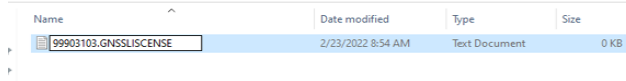
6. While the .txt file is highlighted, click on "View" at the top of the page



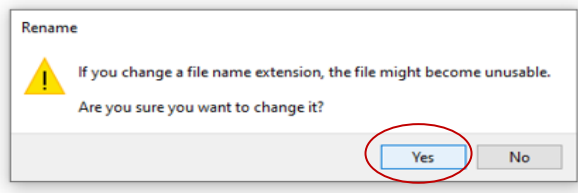
7. Check mark "File name extensions"



8. Rename .txt file to ESN and then .gnsslicense (Ex: 99903103.GNSSlicense)



9. Click "Yes"



10. Eject USB drive and insert into USB port of the MaveriX. It will be automatically detected by the terminal

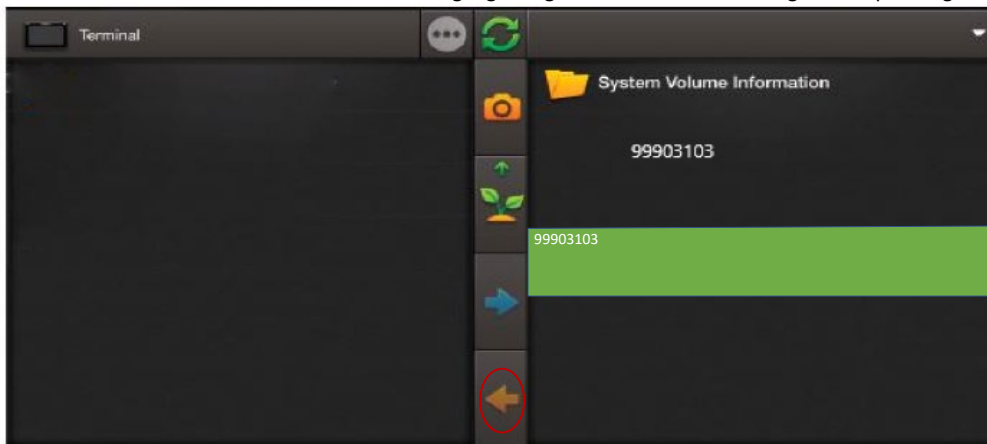
11. Click on the "Home" icon in the lower left of the screen



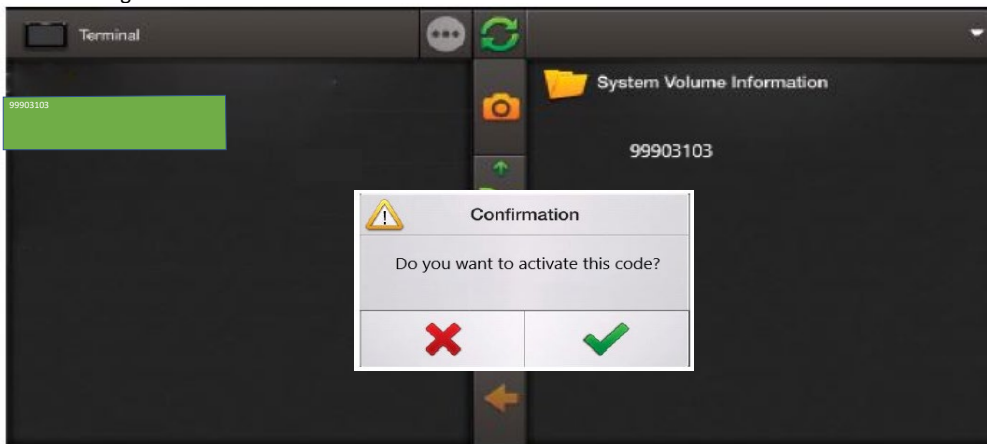
12. Click on "Files"



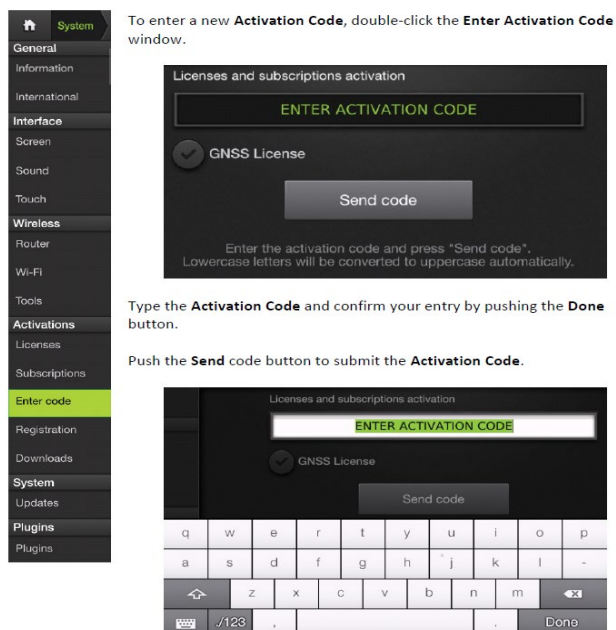
13. Select the file to be transferred and it will highlight in green. Then click the orange arrow pointing to the left



14. Now double tap the transferred file and it will ask you for confirmation that you want to activate the code. Click on the green check mark.



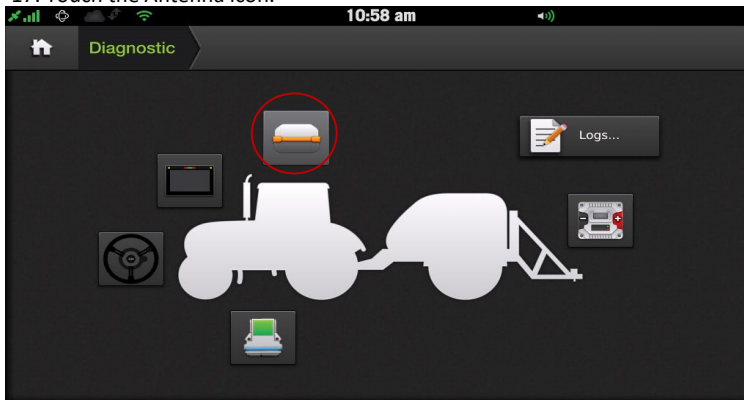
15. You may also follow these instructions to manually input the code.



16. Now go to the Home screen and then to Diagnostic.



17. Touch the Antenna icon.



18. Ensure you are in GPS in Status. Check your Subscriptions and any Expiration Dates you may have. Note: RTK Activations will show in Subscriptions.
